Story CLL	The Egg- MP Robertson Share our lovely story for the week. The Egg	The Egg Read to where he is going to teach him 'dragony' ways and discuss what he might need to teach him. Everyone standing-	Read the book again. Exploring the illustrations and vocabulary. Yesterday we talked about your fantastic	Imagine you woke up this morning and there was a blue egg in your garden. 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	Introduce the book. Look in detail at the front cover and ask chn to share their ideas about the story. Where did the egg come from? How did it get there? What type of boy do they think George is? How would they feel if they found an oversized egg at home or School... Afraid...Excited? Would they do what George did and move the egg into the warmth? Why do you think he did this? Pause the story before the egg hatches. Ask the children what they think might be inside the Egg... A very large chicken, an ostrich, an alien, an angel, a dinosaur or even perhaps a DRAGON! Share ideas and then select an idea to write a sentence.	I want you to show me what you will teach the dragon by using actions only (No talking). Model this by dancing! Can you guess what I am going to teach the dragon? Write a list of things you would teach the dragon to do.	ideas about what you would teach the dragon. What did George teach the dragon? Draw a picture and write a sentence to describe what George taught the dragon. Which idea did you like best?	Write a list of all the different possibilities which could be inside the egg. E.g.
