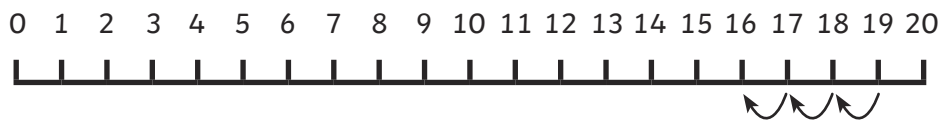
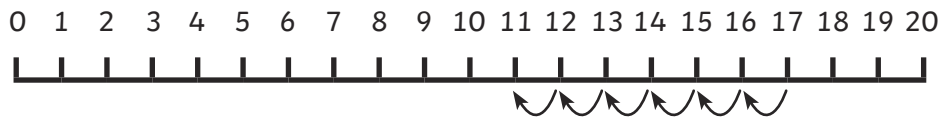


$$19 - 3 = \boxed{16}$$

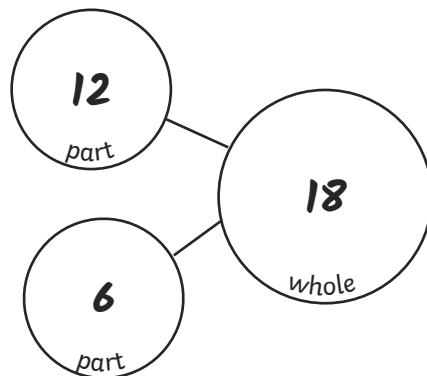
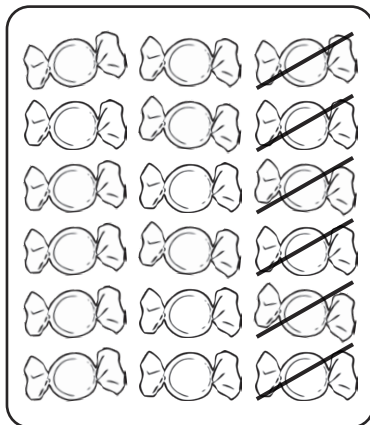


$$17 - 6 = \boxed{11}$$

Now he has **12** sweets.

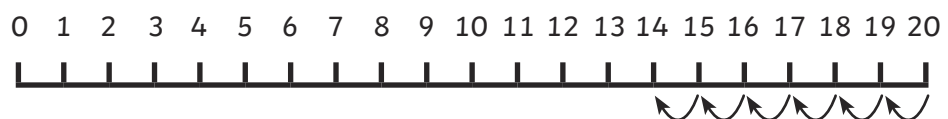


$$\underline{18} - \underline{6} = \underline{12}$$

Freddie included 20 when he was counting back. He should have put 20 'in his head' and started counting back from 19.



$$20 - 6 = 14$$



Children find 8 different calculations:



$$8 - 1 = 7$$

$$8 - 5 = 3$$

$$8 - 2 = 6$$

$$8 - 6 = 2$$

$$8 - 3 = 5$$

$$8 - 7 = 1$$

$$8 - 4 = 4$$
