active

An active volcano is one that might erupt at any time.

ash clouds

A large cloud of ash that pours from the Earth into the sky when a volcano erupts.

crater

The flat area of rock that surrounds a vent.

dormant

A volcano that is not active but may become active.

eruption

When a volcano explodes and hot lava and rocks are released.

extinct

An extinct volcano is one that is not active and will not erupt again.

lava

Hot liquid rock that comes out of the Earth through a volcano.

magma

A hot liquid rock found below the surface of the Earth.

molten rock

Rock that is in a liquid state because it is very hot.

summit

The highest point of a volcano.

tectonic plate

One of the large pieces of rock that makes up the Earth's crust.

vent

The place where lava comes through the Earth's surface.
