Read chapter 8 'Two More Golden Tickets Found'

Are they likeable? What do we know about them so far?

Imagine you are a newspaper reporter interviewing one of the children about finding the Golden Ticket. *What would you ask them? What do you think they would say?*

Choose one of the characters you'd like to interview. Ask 5 questions and answer them in role, expanding answers. Proof read for spelling, grammar and punctuation errors.

LO To answer questions in the role of a character

WEDNESDAY

Read chapter 9 – 'Grandpa Joe takes a gamble'

Find alternative words in the chapter for 'said' and 'went.'

How might the conversation have been different if Charlie **had** found the golden ticket?

Look at a bad example. Correct it.

Write a conversation between Charlie and Grandpa Joe.

LO To use punctuation in dialogue

THURSDAY

Read Chapter 10 'The family begins to starve'.

What should Charlie do with the money he finds? Talk about the different options Charlie could choose. Which would make the most interesting story?

Read Chapter 11 'The Miracle'.

Recall features of a newspaper article (catchy headline, opening paragraph, key facts, picture with caption, quotes, final sentence to bring up to date.)

Write notes for newspaper article. Before writing it.
