Setting/character

Structure	Original	General	New
Opening	Mo goes into the mine. He meets tour guide 'Guy' Lights go off.		

Buildup	Mo went to hold on to classmates hand but he touched a cold rock. Mo is all alone. He meets a miner and is taken to see a working mine.		
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The exciting bit	There is a rockfall. Mo and the miner work to rescue the trapped miners. Mo finds a small silver shovel.		
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Resolution	Mo is found. He then listens to an old miner talking about life in the mines. The old miner has a silver shovel just like the one Mo found. The miner said that only 2 shovels were made and shows the second shovel to Mo.		
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Ending	When he is older, Mo works as a guide in the mine. He still has his silver shovel.		
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
