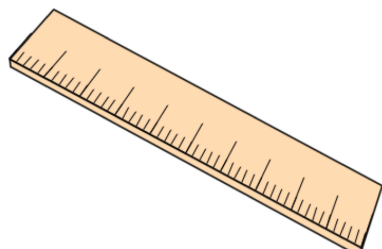

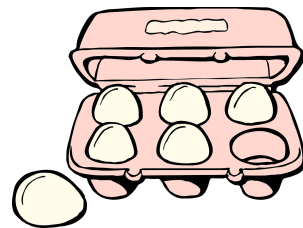

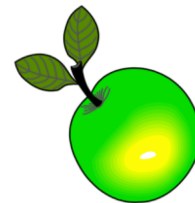
49. Muhammad is given £4 pocket money each week.
