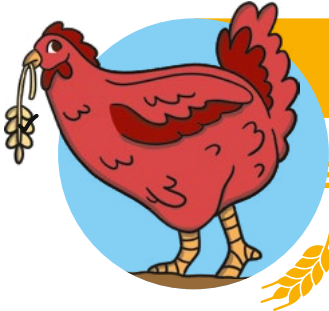


The Little Red Hen

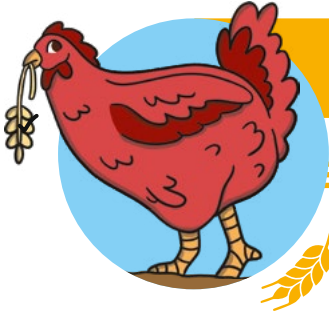

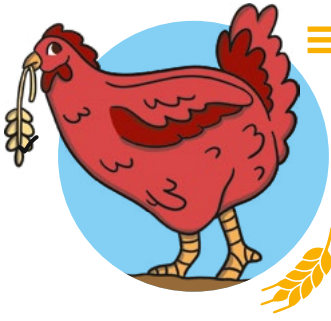
