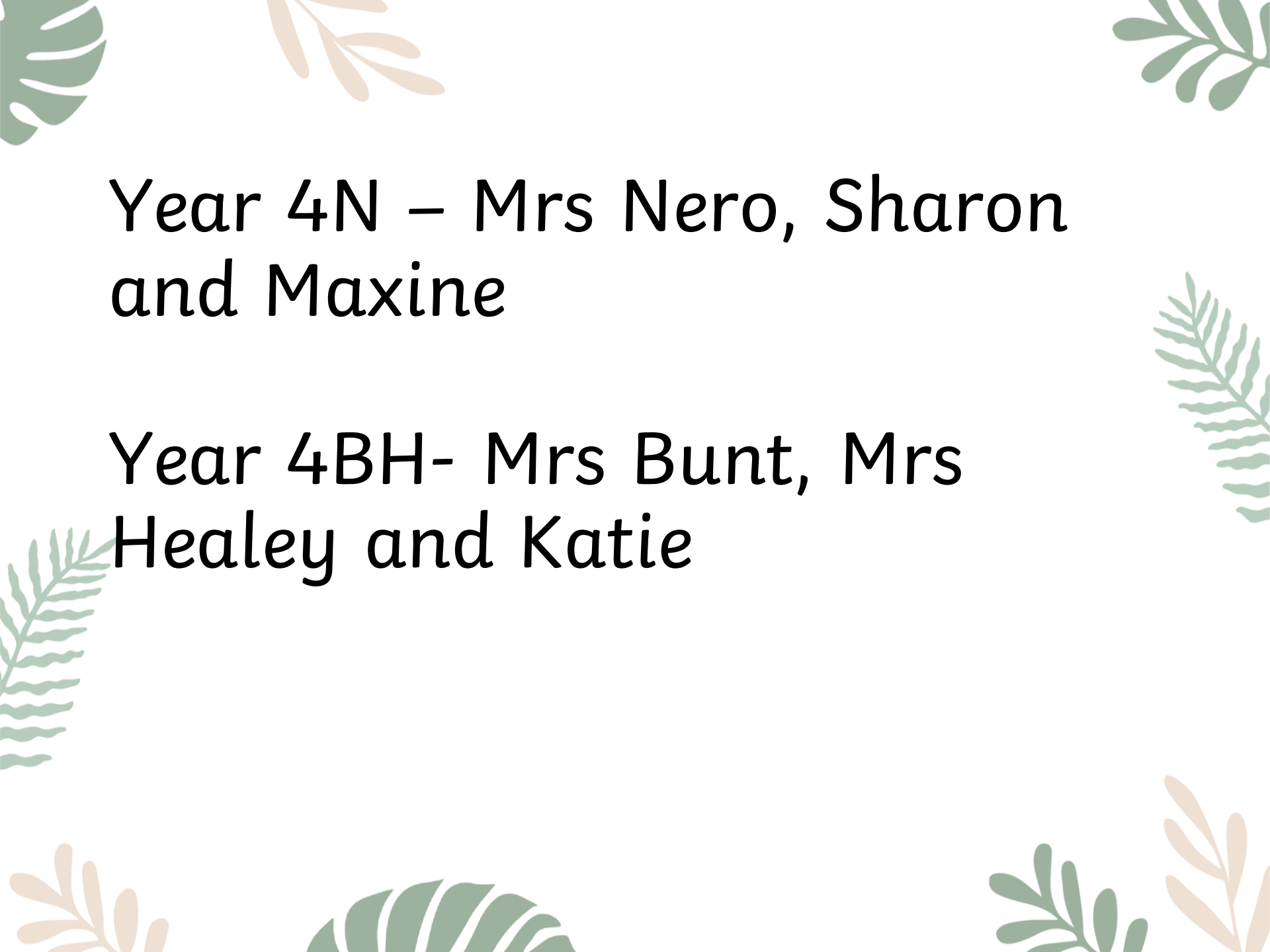

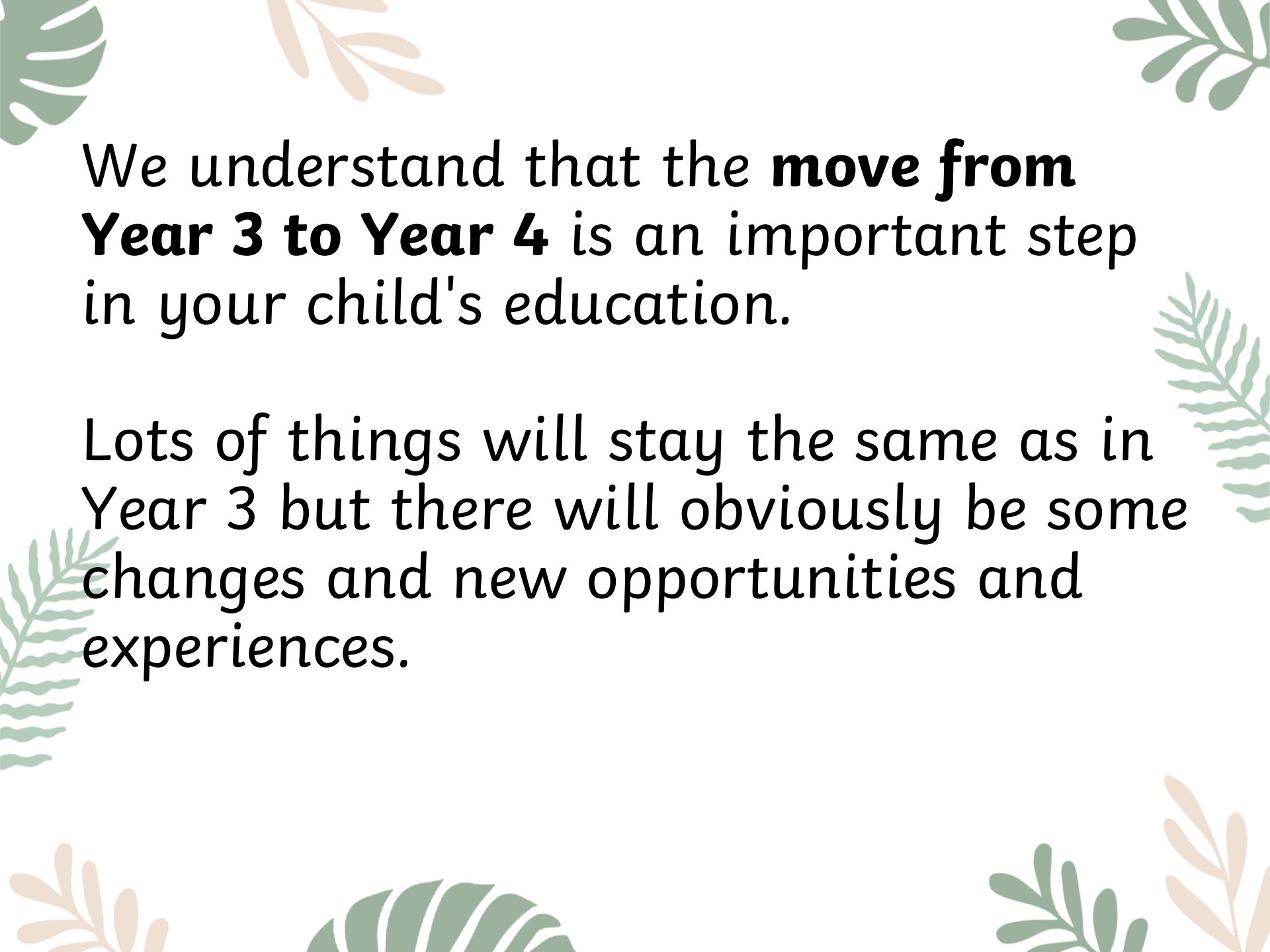

We understand that the **move from Year 3 to Year 4** is an important step in your child's education.

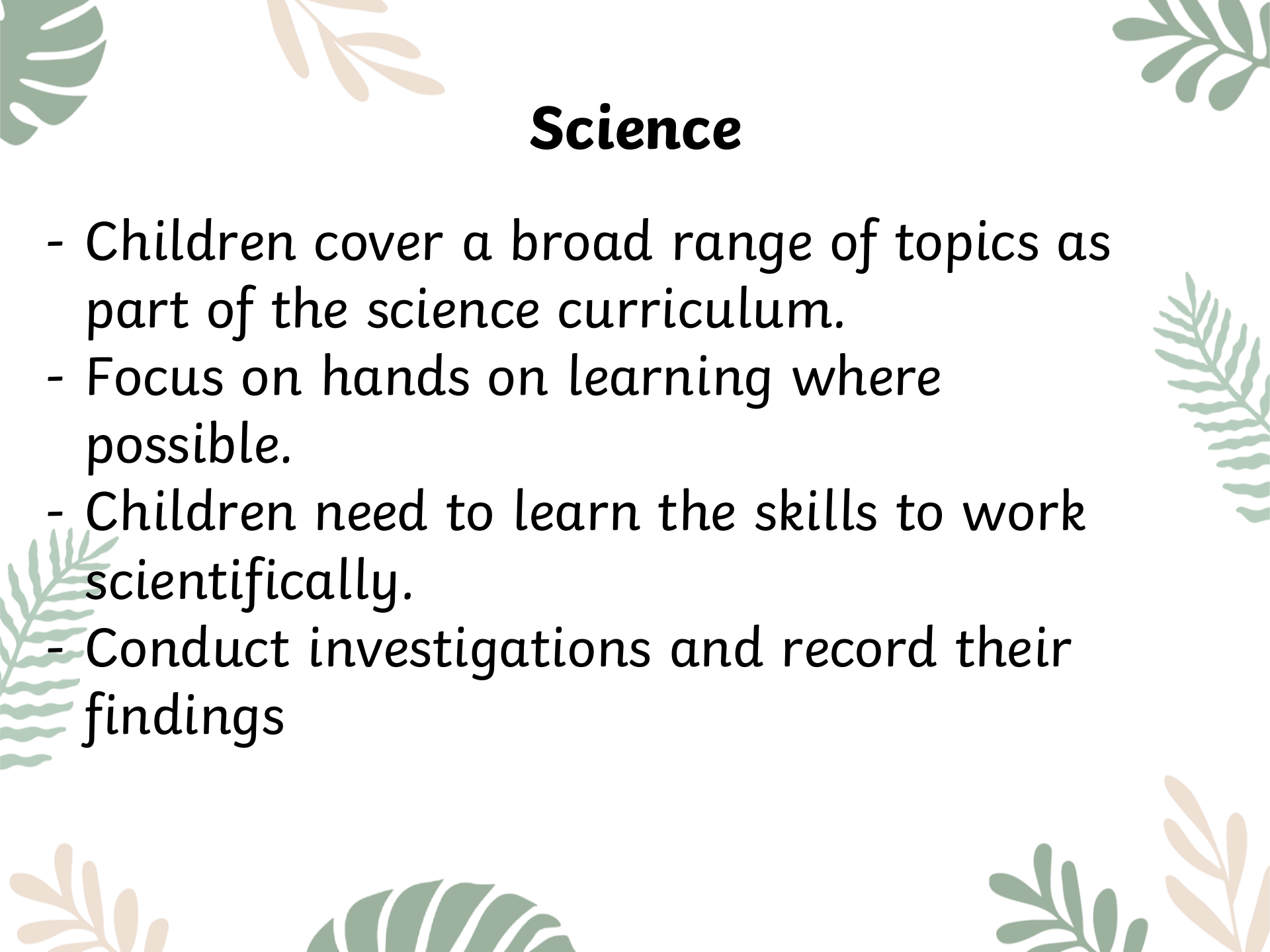
Lots of things will stay the same as in Year 3 but there will obviously be some changes and new opportunities and experiences.

Maths

- Continue to use Power Maths.
- Children will continue to have their own workbooks.
- Power Maths is a mastery based approach which focuses on learning through problem solving and reasoning.
- Fluency sessions separate to maths lesson – main focus is times tables.
- Children will sit a multiplication check in July 2025.

Literacy

- Focus on reading remains: children should be reading at home 3 x 20 minutes. Home reading books changed regularly.
- Will have access to a variety of texts in class for both literacy and whole class reading.
- Links to topic made with texts where possible.
- 2 week teaching block remain for writing.
- Spelling tests continue weekly.



Science

- Children cover a broad range of topics as part of the science curriculum.
- Focus on hands on learning where possible.
- Children need to learn the skills to work scientifically.
- Conduct investigations and record their findings

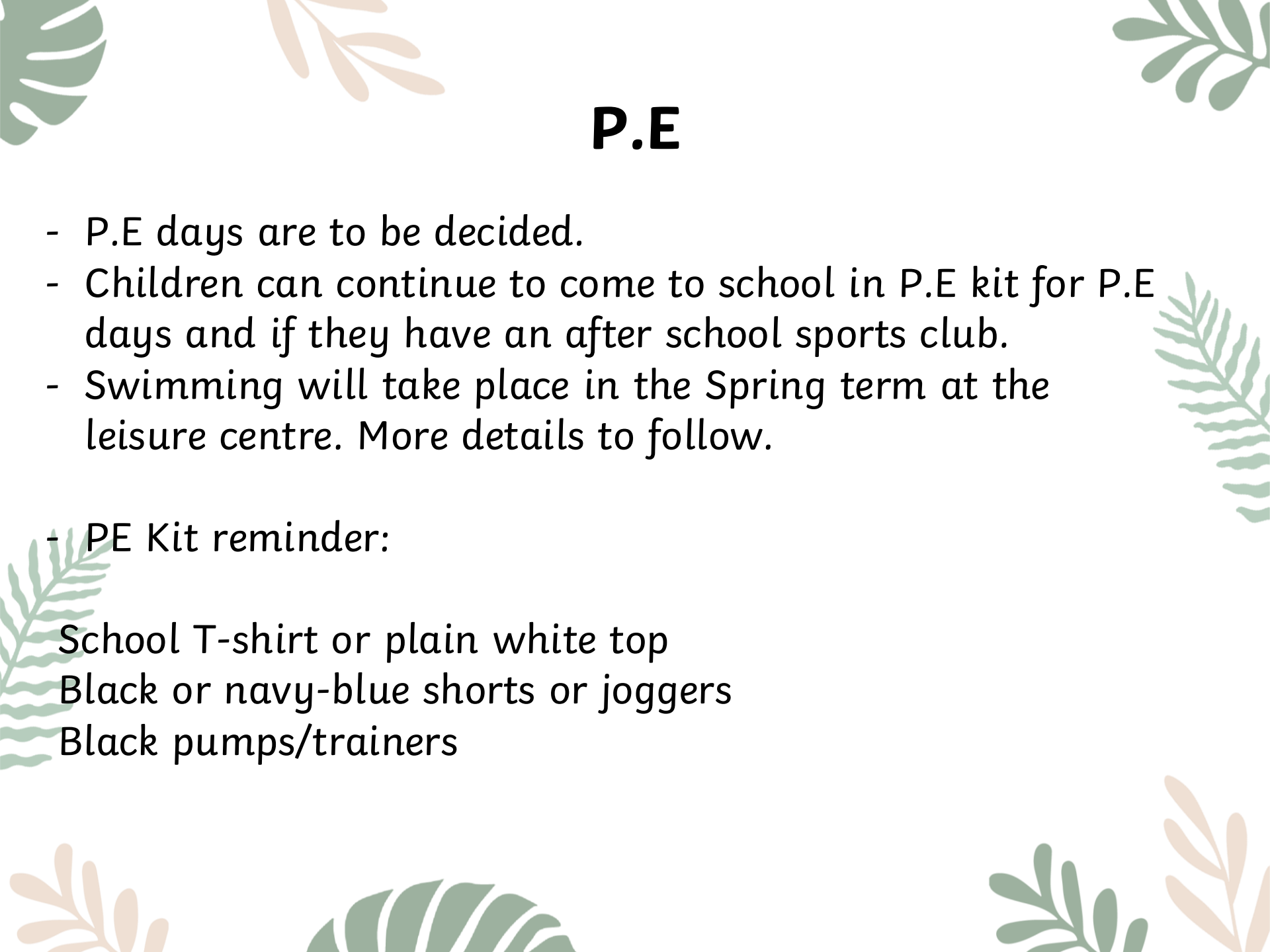
