

Physical Education kit

When children have Physical Education timetabled in their school day, they should attend school in their kit and stay in it throughout the day. This is the same if a child has an extra-curricular activity on any given day as well.

Children should wear kit which is appropriate to the activity that they are taking part in. For example, rugby on the school field in the winter requires a pair of trainers which will get muddy, alongside clothing where the same may happen too.

The exception is swimming, where children should wear school uniform to the swimming pool and take their kit with them to change into once they are there.
