

Library Visits, Chatterbooks and Own Books

Bishopton engages with our local library and throughout the year the children are taken on trips to the library where they participate in workshops which help them discover this reading environment. Parents are contacted regarding how to go about joining the library so that their child can take out books.

Bishopton is also involved in Stratford library's Chatterbooks programme. This involves four children who have been identified as those who would benefit from greater engagement in books going on monthly visits to the library for a whole afternoon. At the library they do a range of book-related activities which encourage the children to discover new books and authors.

Own Books is a locally run scheme which involves children who may not have access to books being allowed to take a book as their own from our library. There is a designated shelf of 'Own Book' which has a wide range of both fiction and non-fiction for children to take. Own Books also carry out assemblies and activities days, such as 'A Day to Dream' where the whole day is spent based upon poetry, reading and art-based activities.
