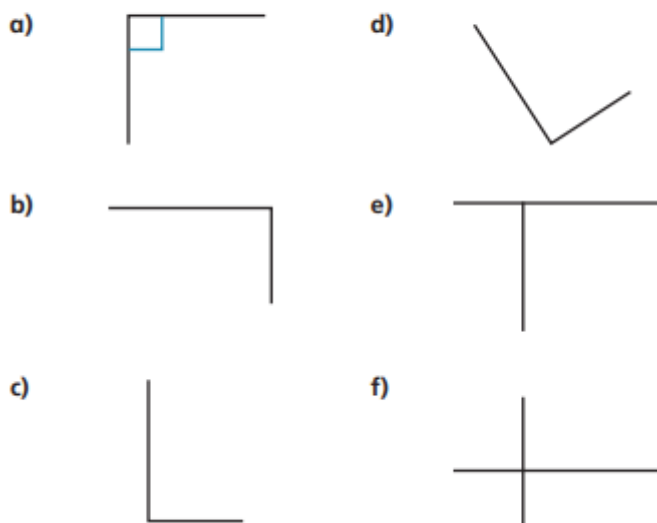


There is at least one right angle in each picture.

Draw three acute angles and label them.

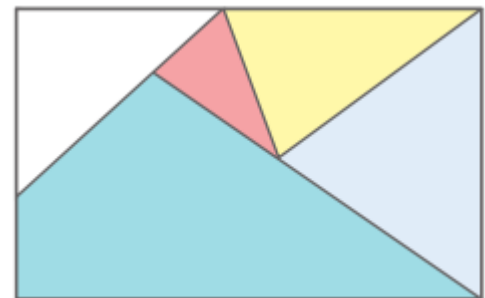
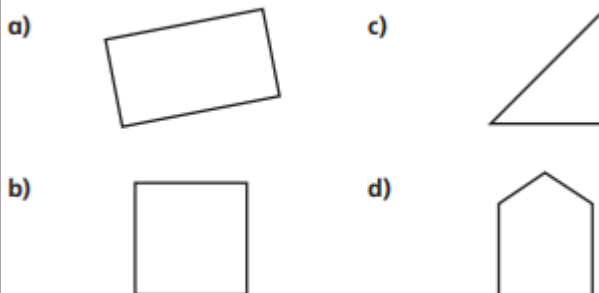
Draw 2 obtuse angles and label them.

I can see five right angles.



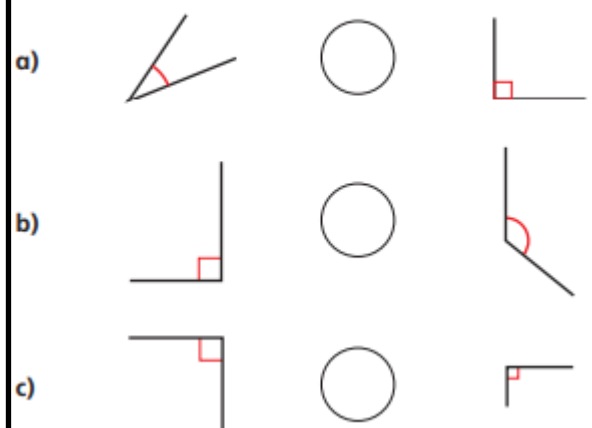
Whitney

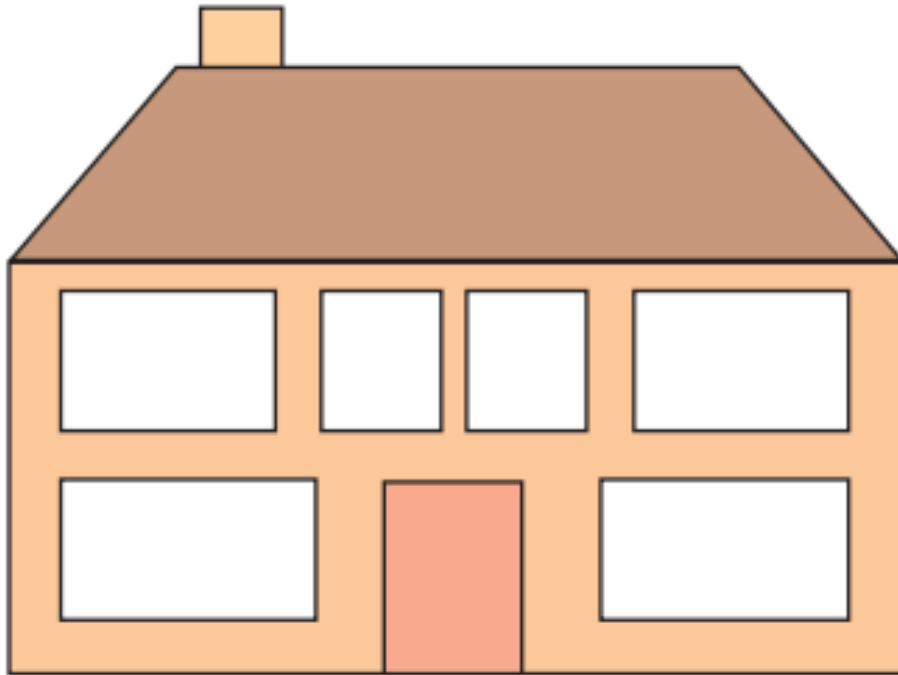
