Monday	Science L.O: To investigate the way in which water is transported within plants. Write about last week's experiment – how many roots sprouted and what did you find out? Read through PowerPoint You are to plan for an experiment using the equipment listed, including a labelled diagram, a method and a prediction. You then need to set up your experiment as planned.
