Poppy

- fruit grows holes in top
- lots of tiny seeds inside
- fruit on top of long stalk



Goosegrass

- 'sticky weed'
- small, round fruits
- light
- covered in tiny, hair-like hooks



Blackberry

- strong colour
- juicy fruit



Mulberry

- Bright colour
- lots of small seeds
- juicy fruit



Cotton

- small seeds
- very light
- fluffy



Red Campion

- round fruit with hole in top
- lots of tiny seeds inside
- fruit on top of long stalk
