Reminder About Wearing the Correct School Uniform

This is a reminder regarding the importance of adhering to the school's uniform policy. Wearing the correct school uniform fosters a sense of belonging and promotes a positive learning environment

Students are expected to wear a **red jumper or cardigan** over a **white shirt or polo shirt**. Bottoms should consist of **black or grey skirts/ dresses or trousers**, complemented by **black shoes**. Please note that trainers or boots are not permitted. Additionally, students should wear **black, white or grey socks or tights** (incl. red tights)

For Physical Education (PE), the uniform consists of **black shorts, leggings, joggers, or skorts**, paired with a **plain white T-shirt**. A **black sweatshirt** is also required for outdoor activities, along with **black pumps or trainers**. We appreciate your cooperation in ensuring that all students are dressed appropriately for school. This not only reflects our school's values but also helps students to focus on their studies without distractions. Thank you for your continued support in upholding our uniform standards.
