Reminder About Wearing the Correct School Uniform

This is a reminder regarding the importance of adhering to the school's uniform policy. Wearing the correct school uniform fosters a sense of belonging and promotes a positive learning environment.

Students are expected to wear a **red jumper or cardigan** over a **white shirt or polo shirt**. Bottoms should consist of **black or grey skirts/ dresses or trousers**, complemented by **black shoes**. Please note that trainers or boots are not permitted. Additionally, students should wear **black or grey socks or tights**.

For Physical Education (PE), the uniform consists of **black shorts, leggings, joggers, or skorts**, paired with a **plain white T-shirt**. A **black sweatshirt** is also required for outdoor activities, along with **black pumps or trainers**.
