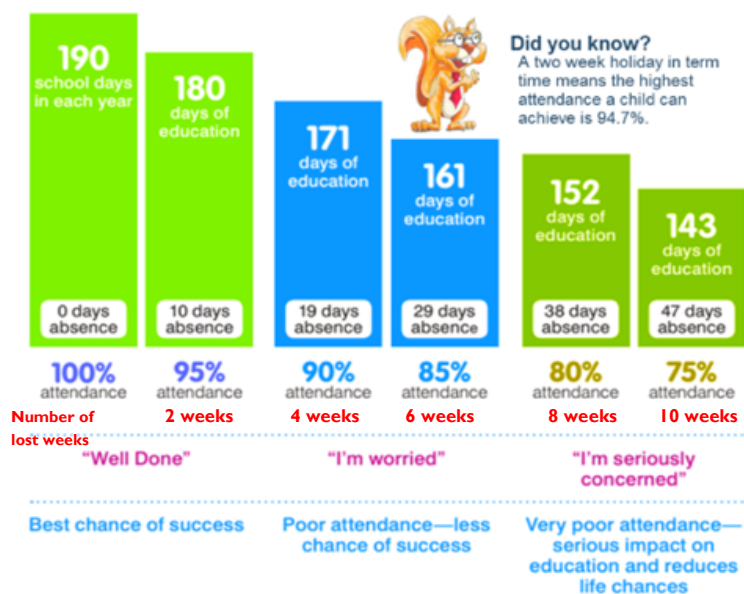

Each half term those children who have achieved 100% attendance will be given the reward of a day in non-uniform and an afternoon with a fun activity. Those children who manage to achieve 100% attendance for the whole year will be given a day trip out in the final week of the school. Of course, we are aware that children can be too ill to come into school which is why we will be offering the opportunity to gain the reward every half term.

The reward system will begin from this term, with children who have achieved 100% attendance rewarded on Wednesday 17th of December with a non-uniform day and afternoon treat and activity. Parents and carers whose children have achieved 100% attendance for the half term will have communication from their child's class teacher.
